1. Journal standards

ICOFOM Study Series (ISS) is the International Committee for Museology's peer-reviewed journal, which is committed to promoting excellence and reflexive thinking within the international museology community and the museum field.

ISS aims to approach critical and theoretical topics of debate in the museum and heritage field as well as in the academic museological world, focusing on articles based on research with the views of museum and heritage professionals, either based on theoretical reflections or on analytical case studies from different contexts around the world.

Each issue is theme-based, and may comprise:

- Theoretical articles, in which original research is brought to light;
- Empirical articles, also based on research and empirical data, which enable museum and heritage professionals to share and learn from peer experience in the field.

2. Recommended approach

The purpose of peer-reviewing is to ensure clarity and journal standards. Difference of opinion with the author should not affect the review.

3. Language

If an article is poorly written, you do not need to correct the English, but you should bring this to the attention of the editor.

4. Quality Checklist

Evaluation criteria:

Specific criteria require grading, on a scale from 0 to 3.

- 0 for 'incomprehensible' or 'irrelevant';
- 1 for 'Does not satisfy the criterion';
- 2 for 'Needs improvement although roughly satisfies the criterion;
- 3 for 'Satisfies the criterion and no improvement is necessary'.
